INFORMED CONSENT

POLICY: General consent to treatment will be obtained before patient is seen. Informed consent for specific invasive procedures will be obtained prior to the procedure.

PROCEDURE:

- 1. The patient will be asked to sign a general statement of consent to treat with the routine paperwork on the first visit. This will cover all procedures not requiring a discussion of risks and benefits.
- 2. For specific invasive procedures, the physician will discuss risks and benefits of the procedure with the patient.
- 3. On all procedures where physician discussed risks and benefits, the patient will then sign an informed consent statement with acknowledgment of risks and benefits.
- 4. There will be no discussion of guarantees of outcomes made.
- 5. Provide patients with any educational material specific to the procedure.
